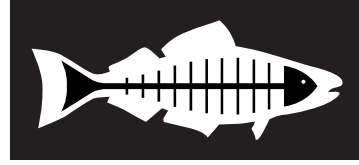

Did you know?

Key to the Sea serves up to 10,000 students/ year; the program has over 10 years of proven success and fun for both teachers and students!

Workshop I/ Year 1 of Program – marine conservation, watersheds, local marine life, the seashore environment, birds, pollution prevention, and more! Includes supply-filled tote bag and curriculum guide!

Workshop II/ Year 2 of Program – builds upon the previous workshop, exploring new topics such as waves and tides, sustainable seafood, habitats and organism adaptations, in-depth sandy beach environment, and more! Includes “make-and-take” teaching tools, curriculum folder, and t-shirt!

Veteran Teacher Participation/ Year 3 and Beyond – If you have completed Workshop I and II, you may participate in the beach exploration field trip for years to come, with no further workshops to attend. Still, it is mandatory that you submit the Veteran Teacher Notification Form (please see next page). This form helps ensure that teachers receive cameras, gift cards, enviro-frames, and other supplies.

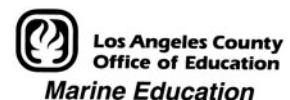

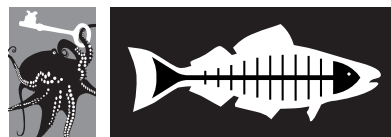
